

## H5N1 HPAI in Dairy Cattle

## Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Available at Gage, Hall, and Madison County Offices

- PPE such as disposable gloves and face shields are available <u>free of charge</u> at Gage, Hall, and Madison county extension offices for dairy workers on a voluntary basis.
- These counties were chosen based on the suggestion from the Nebraska State Dairy Association (NSDA) based on the geographic location and relative number of dairies within Nebraska.
- Supplies are being provided by two agencies:
  - Department of Health and Human Service (DHHS)
  - o Central States Center for Agricultural Safety and Health (CS-CASH)
- The risk of humans contracting H5N1 HPAI virus from dairy cattle appears to be exceedingly low.
- All scientific evidence supports our dairy and beef products remain safe to consumers.
- No appointment needed.
